SELLING A PLANNING PRACTICE: THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN REVENUE MULTIPLE AND REVENUE SIZE

This presentation will convey important information on how to successfully exit a financial planning practice. Planners often rely on appraisers or financial intermediaries to facilitate the exit or succession transition. Results suggest specialized financial intermediaries favored sellers but not buyers. Financial statement items alone did not provide a complete picture of the fair market value. Industry adjustments such as the quality of a practice's clients, the quality of the team, and the quality of the platform tend to reside only within specialized financial intermediaries.

Chia-Li Chien, PhD, CFP®, PMP is Succession Program Director of Value Growth Institute, dedicated to helping women business owners increase the equity value of their firms. She is the award-winning author of 2 books "Show Me the Money" and "Work Toward Reward." Her blog and newsletter were named Top Small Business Resource by the New York Times You're the Boss blog.
